Items Discussed:

1. Title 1 Scavenger Hunt

Debbie Efird will give grade levels a copy of students who participate in the scavenger hunt. Each grade level will decide how to reward students such as homework pass, hat pass, etc.

2. Discipline Plan/Guidelines

We are currently in the planning stage for developing a discipline guideline chart for the next school year. We feel this will help with consistency across all grade levels. We want to implement some type of intervention plan in order to prevent repeat offenders.

3. Daily Mile Walk

There are several schools in our district that piloted a mile walk program this year. This program will consist of teachers walking a mile with students everyday as weather permits.

Teachers will be able to use 5-10 minutes of recess and add an additional 5 minutes at the end or beginning of recess in order to complete the mile. We have been told it takes between 10-15 minutes to complete a mile. This program is not about rewards rather it focuses on the benefits of walking. Again, we are in the planning stage for next year and want each grade levels feedback.

Mandy Stover has requested we switch the grade levels that perform for our Christmas and Spring Programs. She feels that lower grades have more available and cute programs for Christmas. Therefore grades K-2 will perform in December each year and 3-5 will perform in the Spring.
