School Nutrition Services Charge Policy for

Elementary, Middle & High Schools



- Students may charge up to three 3 breakfast and 3 lunch meals.
- No supplemental sales items, such as cookies or ice cream, may be charged at any time.
- No supplemental sales items can be purchased until the student has paid off the meal charges on their account.
- Students in Middle and High Schools will be required to sign a charge log sheet with each meal charged.
- After the charge limit has been met, the student will be given an alternative meal consisting of two (2) vegetables, a fruit, a bread serving and low fat white milk at lunch or graham crackers and low fat white milk for breakfast.
- Our computer system in the cafeteria allows parents to prepay for meals and put money on their students account at www.k12paymentcenter.com.

There will be no exceptions allowed to this charge policy.
