




What is Title I?

Title I is a federally funded program that strives to provide equal opportunity and educational help for all students to succeed in school. The program offers additional training for teachers and tutors, additional training for school staff, extra time for instruction, a variety of teaching methods and materials, and counseling and mentoring, Title I teachers and other staff work closely together.

What type of Title I program is at our school?

Our school has a school-wide program. Schools with 40% or more of children receiving free or reduced price meals are eligible to develop school-wide Title I programs to serve ALL students. Our school combines Title I funds with state and local funds to improve our school.

To provide and sustain a safe environment that promotes many opportunities for discovery and learning.


