Internet at Home for Students

Students will need to be signed in to the RSS filtering service, called Zscaler, to use iPads on home internet. Those students who took their iPads home last year probably won't have to do anything; they should still be signed in to the filter. Students who are connecting school iPads to home internet for the first time, or students who moved to a new house/internet service changed/etc. will need to sign in to the filter again. The steps for signing in have changed. Basically students will be signing in to Google. Here are the steps:

- 1. Connect to your home internet in Settings > Wi-Fi
- 2. Open Safari and navigate to google.com
- 3. On the Google sign in page, enter the student's RSS username followed by "@rssed.org" For example: smithab123@rssed.org
- 4. On the Microsoft sign in page, enter the student's RSS username followed by "@rss.k12.nc.us" For example: smithab123@rss.k12.nc.us
- 5. On the next screen, enter the password is the 10-digit Student ID number
- 6. When it asks "Stay signed in?" click the "Don't show this again" check box, and click "yes"

Important reminders: you <u>must</u> be sure to include "@rssed.org" on the Google sign in page and "@rss.k12.nc.us" on the Microsoft sign in page. If you do not enter these correctly, the sign in process will not work.
